

# **Blog Hosting – FAQ ETH Layout**

FAQ deals with queries regarding blogs in the ETH design.

The "Blog Hosting – FAQs" for all ETH Zurich blogs – which include details gathered from the numerous queries – can be found on ETH Web in the IT service catalogue under "Web and Applications Hosting, Blog Hosting".

#### What is a blog?

A blog or weblog is a kind of diary/journal that is publicly maintained by one or more people.

The following features are typical for blogs:

- Chronological structure: The latest entry appears first at the top.
- Very easy to use for authors and commentators: Low level communication.
- Up-to-datedness: Blogs should be updated regularly with new articles.
- Subjectivity: The entries reflect the personal opinion of the author. In principle, this also applies to corporate blogs. The authors must be therefore selected accordingly.
- Comments: A blog should also include controversial topics. They are brought alive by the comments of the readers.
- Subscribe and syndicate, blogosphere and trackbacks
- Structuring elements categories and tags: Articles in categories have their own URLs and can appear in separate RSS feeds.

## **Request ETH layout**




### **Adjust ETH layout**

ETH has a layout for displaying web pages. This theme is referred to as "ETH Webappcd". This theme can be adjusted for use with a blog.


Once a blog has been created, it can then be adjusted. Every blog needs a theme. Themes are used for displaying web pages. Themes are installed under **Design > Themes**.




Here you should select the ETH theme. To activate a theme, move the mouse cursor over the theme and then click **Activate**.



Once the theme has been selected and activated, you can start customising the web page. To do this, open the dashboard and click **your blog**, which will take you to the main page of your blog.




You will now see a bar with **Customize or Anpassen** above the header. The **Customize** option is used to adjust a theme and can be different for each theme. Open **Customize** now.



Depending on the theme, **Customize** can include a different number of options that can be adjusted. The available options include things such as the colours, the background and the menus, to name just a few. To change something, simply click one of the options and change as required. To save the changes you should use the **Publish** button.

The active theme can also be changed here by using the button Change / Wechseln .
