## **Information for Applicants**

### Who is eligible to apply?

To be eligible to apply for the IARU Summer Global Internship Program @NUS, you must:

- be a current enrolled degree seeking student at one of the IARU universities (except National University of Singapore): Australian National University; ETH Zurich; Peking University; University of California, Berkeley; University of Cambridge; University of Copenhagen; University of Oxford; The University of Tokyo; or Yale University;
- have completed at least one full year of university study; and
- be fluent in English

### How do I apply?

Complete the Application Form and forward it electronically (together with the required supporting documents listed below) to the IARU Coordinator at NUS by **5 November 2015, 2359hr Singapore time**:

- Resume / CV
- Transcript from your home university
- Recommendation Letter from a faculty member
- Testimonial Letter from a previous work supervisor

NUS will request for an interview via Skype or other medium during the selection process. Shortlisted applicants and will be contacted for an interview by **13 November 2015**.

#### How do I enroll in NUS?

Upon acceptance of the NUS offer, successful applicants will complete the enrollment process for student status at the University. NUS will also provide the student with advice on applying for the appropriate visa to enter Singapore. The intern will complete an online application and submit scanned copies of the following supporting documents:

- Printout of completed online application form, with a recent passport-sized photograph
- Offer letter for internship in NUS
- Academic transcript
- Photocopy of passport particulars page
- Letter by home university certifying approved internship
