



ETH Zurich is home to test tubes, measuring instruments and reference books – but also to some 300 works of art. Even from when the university was founded in 1855, attention was paid to artistic design; the architect Gottfried Semper created a lavish interior for the main building. Today, ETH Zurich's art inventory includes works of art from the 19th to the 21st century, mainly by Swiss artists. On this art tour, you'll discover murals, sculptures and works of art on buildings by Augusto Giacometti, Max Bill, Sylvie Fleury, Harald Naegeli and others. Explore the tension between exact science and ambiguous art at the Zentrum or Hönggerberg campus.
